The 17 SDGs are integrated—that is, they recognize that action in one area will affect outcomes in others, and that development must balance social, economic and environmental sustainability.

Through the pledge to Leave No One Behind, countries have committed to fast-track progress for those furthest behind first. That is why the SDGs are designed to bring the world to several life-changing 'zeros', including zero poverty, hunger, AIDS, and discrimination against women and girls.

• Going From a Rentier Economy to a Multi-resource Economy

The University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa embraces the first international scientific conference hosted by the Al-Wareth Academy for Human Development and Strategic Studies.

An international scientific conference in cooperation with the Faculty of Administration and Economics at the University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa under the auspices of the General Secretariat of the Imam Hussainiya Shrine and in cooperation with the Al-Wareth Academy for Human Resources Development and Strategic Studies continues to complete special preparations. This first international scientific conference was held on 16/1/2021 under the title (Economic transformation from a rentier economy to a multi-resource economy) in the presence of elite professors of administration and economics at Iraqi universities and representatives of The Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, as well as representatives of the Iraqi Sunni Council, academic figures and researchers.

On this day, the activities of the conference began with a dialogue session in which some issues and forms related to the conference's axes were reviewed and were reviewed with the help of the number of experiences and case studies of other countries to benefit from by hosting a group of scientific and academic bodies in the economic, administrative and financial field to look into this matter.

There were other research sessions on the hubs of the conference, and the researchers that reached the conference were involved in the discussion, where these researchers address the problem for which the conference was held and how to find solutions to get rid of the problem of reliance on one oil resource in financing the country's general budget.

The process of diagnosing this problem has been reached via studies and research and these indicators have been adopted by the Warith Academy for more than two years, and this conference was held for bringing such strategies for the purpose of not relying on the country's main budget on the on oil only in its revenues because oil has been affected by political crises and International

situation and its negative impact on climate, and this impact is reflected on Iraq, and hence it poses a great danger to our country; its future and for generations to come. We hope that the efforts of this conference will be noticed by the Iraqi Government, the Ministry of Planning, and the Ministry of Finance for the purpose of relieving the budget of the Iraqi government from the oil economy and its removal from its crises.

• Financial Aid, Subsidies, and Scholarships

The University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa being a non-profit organization dedicates a large sum of its profits to supporting students in need. These students came from deprived backgrounds including several sectors, orphans students, children of martyrs, displaced families due to ongoing terrorism and invasion by ISIS, and deserving yet talented students who are not able to support

their studies to name a few, as university deals scholarship matters on a case by case basis, these scholarships include a 100%, 50% and 10% tuition fee waiver with other subsidies (free transport and subsidized hostel for female students). The university of Warith Al-Anbiyaa has even launched its application for receiving scholarship applications for students from far-fetched remote areas who might not be able to apply on time in person or due to travel distance and the cost of traveling couldn't afford university visits. With the Grace of God, the university of Warith Al-Anbiyaa was able to provide scholarships to a large number of students, our honorable mention is a 100% tuition fee discount for medical students from deserving backgrounds, most of the students came from orphaned families, and these students comprise of 10% of the year 2021 intake for college of medicine in the university of Warith Al-Anbiyaa, list of the names of the students can be found <u>here.</u> There were so many other students from other departments included in the list, who were able to get 100%, 50%, and 10% scholarships, All of our female students enjoy subsidized accommodation with luxury standards and free transportation services to and fro from the hotel to the university.

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• Funds Collection on Short Notice

Ata ul Warith has reached another mark by collecting 1.5 million Iraqi dinars for helping a poor family in need. The family in question consists of an old woman and her sick son, as she too is taking care of twenty-three orphaned kids despite her poor condition; they live in a slum area and don't have access to basic necessities, and even lack food and other basic medical care. Team Ata ul Warith with the help of donors was able to come to aid this poor woman, funds were used to buy food and groceries for the poor woman and her dependents including 23 orphaned children, and cover basic healthcare expenses for her sick son. However, due to the dignity of the family in question, we avoid uploading any pictures of the family receiving aid from Team Ata ul Warith, this kind of behavior is not part of our policy, so as not to hurt anyone by uploading them receiving help from team Ata ul Warith. We appreciate our student members from the

volunteer and philanthropic team of the sustainability club; named Ata ul Warith, for following high moral and ethical standards while helping people in need.

• Agriculture Mapping of Karbala, Iraq

A scientific meeting between the University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa, the University of Karbala, and the Ministry of Agriculture Karbala, Iraq, contribute to the development of the agricultural map of the Holy City of Karbala.

As part of its endeavor to participate in providing community services in the holy city of Karbala. According to the articles of the scientific agreement between the University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa and the University of Karbala

Mr. Administrative Assistant Professor Dr. Nawafel Al-Arji and Dean of the Faculty of Administration and Economics Mr. Dr. Awad Al-Khalidi, the delegation of the Faculty of Agriculture at Karbala University headed by Dean of College Professor Dr. Thamer Karim Khadir to discuss how to develop the agricultural map of the holy city of Karbala.

Investment in scientific and academic experiences at the University of the Heirs of the Prophets (peace be upon him) and the University of Karbala to provide community services, this meeting was held to discuss with the delegation of the Ministry of Agriculture how to qualify and develop the agricultural map of the Holy Karbala Governorate with several other important topics that touch the agricultural realm such as soil analysis and water sources, organizing and improving the production of agricultural crops, types of agricultural machinery used, how to market the product and operate the manpower, as well as strategic crop cultivation in accordance with the scientific foundations of agriculture.

God willing, the research progress and finalization will be continuously reported to the General Secretariat of the Holy Husseinia Shrine, which always supports and encourages such service and philanthropic projects.

Both parties agreed to prepare preliminary studies including the research questions that can be asked and discussed in order to find solutions for them through discussion and in-depth research.

A research team for this topic consists of representatives from both universities i.e University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa and the University of Karbala and appointed officials from the Ministry of Agriculture of Karbala Governorate, however, the door has been left open and there is an open call for other agricultural specialists to contribute to this project from any government and nongovernment sector.



• Food Pack Donations in Slums

Students from the university of Warith Al-Anbiyaa along with staff members donated for the distribution of food packets to deserving families in the poor neighborhoods during the month of Ramadan, volunteer team from Ata ul Warith helped load the truck and distributed packs themselves despite the hot summer of Karbala Iraq during the fasting period of Ramadan, volunteer team makes sure to deliver food before the sunset so that families can have their fill during their iftar (when the finished their fast) during Ramadan month. 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• Free Medical Camp for Tourists

Background:

Due to a gradual increase in the culture of smoking and smoking cafes in the Holy City of Karbala, the University of Warith AlAnbiyaa (peace be upon him) is set to be a smoke-free organization completely. We, the top management of the university of Warith AlAnbiyaa A.S, in light of the major health implications posed by smoking, deemed it necessary to introduce a no-smoke culture in our organizations, not just to avoid its serious health hazards for smokers, but to help diminish a second-hand smoke health side effects, for it's a well-established claim proven by scientific research that second-hand smoke dangers are no less than health detriments being faced by smokers themselves. Also most importantly prepare students to work in smoke-free organizations in the future e.g Hospitals and Junior and Higher Secondary Schools.

- 1. Smoking is prohibited in all its forms (tobacco, non-tobacco smoking, hookah/shisha, vaping, e-cigarettes) throughout the campus of the university.

4. In case when students/ staff members are trying to get rid of their smoke addiction, antismoking consultation is provided in our health center on campus and designated places in hospitals attached/affiliated to the university.

5. If anyone is found smoking within the area of the university, the Head of the Human Resources Department will investigate the nature of the incident, and forward the case to upper management to deal with the issue; dependent upon the severity of the issue in question.

• Encouraging Female Students to Apply

Women's role in building society can't be denied, the need is to educate and train them, so they're able to perform at the peak of their abilities. Gender inequality is dominant in Middle Eastern culture, despite the need of almost every other household for their women to participate in bread-winning due to ever-increasing inflation and a rise in male civilian deaths, during Iraq's latest struggle in the fight against ISIS and during wars and invasions.

The University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa deemed it its responsibility to help build a women-inclusive society. As an educational institution, we believe we can help educate our girls/women to better equip them with resources and potential to be independent enough to support themselves, we, therefore, try our best to maintain a healthy male-to-female ratio and support admission rate by offering dedicated scholarships for deserving students with a large recipient of our scholarship being female. Several scholarship quotas are in place for war-stricken states and governorates during the invasion of ISIS. We make sure to offer women-only quotas for gender-specific seats for scholarships, avoiding any non-binary gender entrance into women's schemes, so as to not limit their chance of acceptance by awarding funded seats to other genders or X.

Special accommodation only for females with high security and subsidized fees with free transportation is offered for all female students, so as to increase the number of applications from female applicants from far-fetched and remote regions of our country. This has shown a remarkable improvement in the application rate from females, as the enrollment of female students in Warith Al-Anbiyaa has increased remarkably over time.

• How We're Taking Care of Disadvantaged Groups Among Us

Each year a percentage of female students drop out of higher education due to financial difficulties or the culture and trend of getting married during higher education, however, little has been done to support the changes being dealt with by newlywed couples. The University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa, therefore, has put several measures in place to help students in similar situations. Other than this, women from far-fetched or remote areas or female students who're the first-ever women to receive a higher degree in their family, who've to face some hurdles and resistance from their families are also on the verge of leaving their studies or not starting at all for worst. We at the University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa have tried our best to introduce such a culture and support system in our prestigious university, where everyone can access support system and enjoy the same privileges as other genders on and off campus.

Scholarship quota for female students to maintain the healthy ratio of different genders studying on scholarship, the system is merit-based, however, preference is to be given to a female candidate when competing with male students with similar/competitive percentages and averages.

Loan for dealing with financial difficulties and hardships (accommodating Female students with empathetic female staff, with their privacy fully respected)

Mental health counseling for dealing with ongoing hardships, including but not limited to abusive relationships, depression, anxiety, stress, divorce/breakups, post-partum depression after childbirth, adjusting to a new environment, coping with life after marriage, getting bullied, dealing with post harassment impact

Women mentoring schemes include training for technical and non-technical skills; including workshops for resiliency and English language, topics under the mental health counseling center, entrepreneurship, helping with new business launch

The female student community center promotes a sense of belonging for female students who feel intimidated in the new higher education environment and evade the feeling of being left out

Affordable high-standard accommodation with high securities and amenities, with no (*or say minimizing*) return on investment to encourage participation from the low-income sector from remote regions

Free transportation to and fro from the university to the hostel to help students with the cost of living in Karbala, with expensive transportation due to religious tourism

Creating a sense of belonging for female students via anti-bullying, and anti-harassment policies, promoting active female student participation, and women's inclusion in major activities/schemes

Online Module/Virtual attendance option for students in emergency situations or in a new phase of their lives, so as to maximize their participation, making female students encourage to attend virtually instead of dropping out

Parents' involvement, engage with parents to make them interested in their daughter's studies and have a sense of pride in their daughter's achievement. Primarily targeted parents are from conservative backgrounds originating from or residing in small towns and villages, who're not comfortable with the idea of letting their daughters study in higher education institutions.

Student support center with qualified emotionally intelligent/empathizing staff, trained enough to be a good communicator and listener; never allowing a scenario of letting students down or making them feel embarrassed.

Displacement of students' families due to war or other terrorist activities. Special support programs for girls or female students to support them with their studies via loans, fee deferrals, scholarships, fee installment options, and preference granted for subsidized housing.



• Water Conservation

New scientific research by the Dean of the Faculty of Engineering at the University of Warith Al-Abiyaa, the researcher and academician Dr. Hakim Al-Jubouri, dean of the Faculty of Engineering with the participation of a number of researchers, Abdulkhadr Aziz Mutcher and the researcher A. D. Fadel Mohammed from the university of Forat Al-Awsat is doing joint applied research in the World Journal of Engineering Sciences and Technology, which is part of the Scopus and Clarivate database (Q2).

Dr. Hakim Al-Jubouri said: This research is considered applied research in Karbala Governorate, which is a practical assessment of groundwater in the green belt of Dubba region within the governorate

• Agriculture Mapping of Karbala, Iraq

A scientific meeting between the University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa, the University of Karbala, and the Ministry of Agriculture Karbala, Iraq, contribute to the development of the agricultural map of the Holy City of Karbala.

As part of its endeavor to participate in providing community services in the holy city of Karbala. According to the articles of the scientific agreement between the University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa and the University of Karbala

Mr. Administrative Assistant Professor Dr. Nawafel Al-Arji and Dean of the Faculty of Administration and Economics Mr. Dr. Awad Al-Khalidi, the delegation of the Faculty of Agriculture at Karbala University headed by Dean of College Professor Dr. Thamer Karim Khadir to discuss how to develop the agricultural map of the holy city of Karbala.

Investment in scientific and academic experiences at the University of the Heirs of the Prophets (peace be upon him) and the University of Karbala to provide community services, this meeting was held to discuss with the delegation of the Ministry of Agriculture how to qualify and develop the agricultural map of the Holy Karbala Governorate with several other important topics that touch the agricultural realm such as soil analysis and water sources, organizing and improving the production of agricultural crops, types of agricultural machinery used, how to market the product and operate the manpower, as well as strategic crop cultivation in accordance with the scientific foundations of agriculture.

God willing, the research progress and finalization will be continuously reported to the General Secretariat of the Holy Husseinia Shrine, which always supports and encourages such service and philanthropic projects.

Both parties agreed to prepare preliminary studies including the research questions that can be asked and discussed in order to find solutions for them through discussion and in-depth research.

A research team for this topic consists of representatives from both universities i.e University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa and the University of Karbala and appointed officials from the Ministry of Agriculture of Karbala Governorate, however, the door has been left open and there is an open call for other agricultural specialists to contribute to this project from any government and nongovernment sector.



• Water Conservation/Recycling Program On Campus 1. Conservation

All the buildings of the University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa have a separate sewerage system, for wastewater and for clean water. Rainwater is thus collected from the roofs of the buildings and is then discharged into the local ponds and canals around the buildings. Thus, the rainwater is collected from the roof, parking areas, and other places at the campus and discharged the rainwater into the ponds and channels at our campus. Rainwater is mainly used for watering the green lands at the university and for fountains.



2. Recycling

There is a water treatment plant located right beside our campus area. Although Iraq has a dry climate and doesn't see much rain, especially since our city Karbala has been hit severely by the impact of climate change, we haven't seen much rain in the last years, so the amount of rainwater in Iraq is not that much in comparison with other countries; however, when there is rainwater it is discharged directly to university gardens for watering the trees and plants, for the garden sprinkler system and fountains. And as clean drinking water is necessary for sustaining life and due to the contamination of natural freshwater sources, the University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa has an integrated system to purify water at the campus. The water system at the university help in improving the process of transforming wastewater into a clean and recyclable source of drinking

water. In this system, the water runs through a series of water filters to remove contaminants and debris and transform wastewater into safe drinking water, water treated by this plant is consumed by students and staff.







• Water pollution control in campus area

The University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa is trying to be a plastic-free university and reduce paper waste, as they have been a major source of contaminants of water sources and endangering aquatic life, university researchers are active in research for reducing water contaminations, there are several such policies active in university, other than that university has water treatments plants for recycling rainwater into safe drinking water, as clean drinking water is necessary for sustaining life and due to the contamination of natural freshwater sources

• Relieving Iraq from its Reliance on Oil

The University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa embraces the first international scientific conference hosted by the Al-Wareth Academy for Human Development and Strategic Studies.

An international scientific conference in cooperation with the Faculty of Administration and Economics at the University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa under the auspices of the General Secretariat of the Imam Hussainiya Shrine and in cooperation with the Al-Wareth Academy for Human Resources Development and Strategic Studies continues to complete special preparations. This first international scientific conference was held on 16/1/2021 under the title (Economic transformation from a rentier economy to a multi-resource economy) in the presence of elite professors of administration and economics at Iraqi universities and representatives of The Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, as well as representatives of the Iraqi Sunni Council, academic figures and researchers.

On this day, the activities of the conference began with a dialogue session in which some issues and forms related to the conference's axes were reviewed and were reviewed with the help of the number of experiences and case studies of other countries to benefit from by hosting a group of scientific and academic bodies in the economic, administrative and financial field to look into this matter.

There were other research sessions on the hubs of the conference, and the researchers that reached the conference were involved in the discussion, where these researchers address the problem for which the conference was held and how to find solutions to get rid of the problem of reliance on one oil resource in financing the country's general budget.

The process of diagnosing this problem has been reached via studies and research and these indicators have been adopted by the Warith Academy for more than two years, and this conference was held for bringing such strategies for the purpose of not relying on the country's main budget on the on oil only in its revenues because oil has been affected by political crises and International situation and its negative impact on climate, and this impact is reflected on Iraq, and hence it poses a great danger to our country; its future and for generations to come. We hope that the efforts of

this conference will be noticed by the Iraqi Government, the Ministry of Planning, and the Ministry of Finance for the purpose of relieving the budget of the Iraqi government from the oil economy and its removal from its crises.



• Aesthetic Solar Trees for Charging

• Reducing Inequalities at Warith Al-Anbiyaa

We at the university of Warith Al-Anbiyaa believe highly in striving our best for leveling the platform for people of different needs, so that they won't feel left out, here are some of our efforts towards this cause of inclusion and breaking inequality barriers.

1. Disabled parking for disabled people to park their car which is located at the nearest space building, also there's a dedicated car park area for disabled people near the building, they can utilize the same area for entrance and exit for their ease

2. Dedicated scholarships for disabled, needy orphans, war victims, people with special needs, and financially disadvantaged students and special consideration, the quota for hiring people with disabilities

3. Accessible toilets for disabled people are provided everywhere, in every washroom area, there's a large extra dedicated area for people in need, as the size of the washroom/toilet can be seen by the photo above, its size is more than double that of normal toilets, even the entrance door size is larger than regular toilets. throughout the university

4.Ramps and paths for wheelchairs at the entrances/towards main buildings/areas/grounds being used by staff and students

5. The lactation room is under construction along with on-campus daycare for parents (staff and students)





• Free Transportation Service to Hostelites

We believe the students visiting our university from far-fetched areas especially women from disadvantaged backgrounds or displaced families from the remote regions of Iraq, are under significant threat to excel in higher education and appear in the field of STEM, keeping that thing in mind, the University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa gave 100%, 50% and 10% scholarship to its students and special consideration was given to deserving top students from a financially poor background, were to encourage them to enter a STEM field, we assign 100% scholarships to top 10% of financially disadvantaged students in medicine department. However we know in the Holy city of Karbala, due to its commitment to entertaining massive crowds, the cost of living here can be highly expensive, for that reason, we at the university of Warith Al-Anbiyaa not only provide subsidized housing facilities to our students but also provide free transport services to and fro from

university to hostel and back. As for our female students, we have made sure to give them lodging in the city center with complete security and with 24 hours guards' presence, although the accommodation lies within tight security of the city provided by the Governorate of Karbala due to the sensitive points nearby, moreover, the area where the hostel is located have markets on walking distance and our students can find stuff for daily needs without any need for commuting. As the University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa provides free of cost transportation provided by the Directorate of Imam Hussain Holy Shrine (AS) (Parent organization of the university of Warith Al-Anbiyaa) which serves inside Karbala city to pick up students from their homes/hostel to the university and vice versa about three to five times a day (in total, both to and fro trip combined), we intend to complete our on-campus dormitories for our students so as to avoid commuting expenses and the toll on climate.





• Pedestrian paths throughout the campus

It can be seen from the university photos below that the pedestrian pathway is durable enough, not slippery, and free from any form of obstruction. There is periodic maintenance such as cleaning the road of debris, trash, weeds, etc. In terms of pathway design; the pedestrian pathway is wide enough, connected with other facilities like a parking area and bus stop. Also, it is colored, patterned, and clear from the unpleasant smell of garbage and rotten stuff. Also, it's been made sure to add benches or seats, lawns, plants, trash bins, signage, and street lighting beside the sidewalk







• Aesthetic Solar Trees for Charging

The university of Warith Al-Anbiyaa despite being in its early years is trying to be smart and efficient for energy consumption, we're trying to introduce such initiatives gradually in our university that will pave way for a smarter and more sustainable future. Here's one such example of our sustainable initiatives, which might be drop in the ocean of sustainability-relevant initiatives being carried out by other sustainably responsible organizations, but given our age and size, it's just a good start for us to start investing in the energy-efficient projects, as we're already quite active in philanthropic causes and SDG 1, 2, and 3 and similar others. So for energy efficiency university is introducing solar energy-based charging outlets for electric vehicles and other electronic devices, these outlets are mostly used by students on our campus for charging their electronic equipment and electric bikes. • Smart Building Design Warith Al-Anbiyaa

Al Ola and Al-Isma buildings along with the College of Law at the University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa have been constructed with elements of green building and smart construction in mind, buildings have been constructed in such a way that there is less need of artificial lightning during day hour and rooms and corridors in buildings enjoy a natural source of daylight, other relevant construction styles concerning heat and ventilation system has also been put in consideration while designing these buildings, this is apparent from the photos below, where Al-Ola and Al-Isma buildings share similar design principles.







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• Heading Towards a Socially Responsible Paperless Organization by 2025

We're trying to be a paperless organization and minimize the use of paper in our university's colleges by encouraging our students to submit digital and soft copies f their assignments on our online learning portal (Moodle), students are simply asked by their respective teachers to submit assignments in the soft form rather than in the hard forms, as hard copies won't be accepted or encouraged, as soft copies of assignments can also help our teaching staff to detect and report plagiarism or matched content within a class, not only this is beneficial for sustainability regarding less paper use, it's also helped a lot in improving quality of our education system and made student strive and extend their boundaries via researching and creativity to fulfill the assignment requirements.

As for office organization work, we are trying our best to promote and instill Green behavior in our staff and employees, by promoting green living and corporate social responsibility via distributing free coffee mugs and banning paper and plastic cups from our kitchen, encouraging them to bring their water bottles for refilling or else use recyclable glass provided with water dispensary.





Digital banners for limiting the use of paper and having infographics and posters encouraging limiting the use of paper as much as possible, adding a signature with every email Inter/Intra department for discouraging printing has been a good reminder for our staff to think before they print anything. Having Stand rolls, A4 size posters and digitally placed information has helped subliminally motivate our employees to adopt green behavior. We not only do that but arrange workshops for our students and employees for achieving sustainable goals, to make them adapt

this behavior more quickly, we tend to make them aware of the ill effects of non-green behavior on our environment and for us, for psychology, says people tend to adopt and accept new behavior more quickly when given a reason behind its use and importance, rather than just ordering it, not only that we're making green activities student and staff inclusive, as their participation in such programs and activities is more likely to be adopted by them. Here are some examples of psychological tactics on how we encourage our employees to move towards a paperless office, find both in text and visuals

1.50% of the waste of the businesses is composed of paper

Solution: Use software, not paper to collect and store data

2. Recycling 1 ton of paper saves

Solution: Use extra, discarded office copies for note-taking. Up to 50% of paper waste can be reduced via such practices.

3. Demand for paper is going to double before 2030

Solution: Use email instead of paper for inter/intra-department communication as much as possible

4. Paper accounts for 25% of landfill waste

Solution: Use discarded, used paper materials via recycling or shredding them to be shared with our contractors to be used as packing material for shipments

5. The average web-user prints 27 pages daily

Solution: If printing paper is unavoidable, print it on both sides; 50% less paper consumed



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God willing, the research progress and finalization will be continuously reported to the General Secretariat of the Holy Husseinia Shrine, which always supports and encourages such service and philanthropic projects.

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A research team for this topic consists of representatives from both universities i.e University of Warith Al-Anbiyaa and the University of Karbala and appointed officials from the Ministry of Agriculture of Karbala Governorate, however, the door has been left open and there is an open call for other agricultural specialists to contribute to this project from any government and non-government sector.
